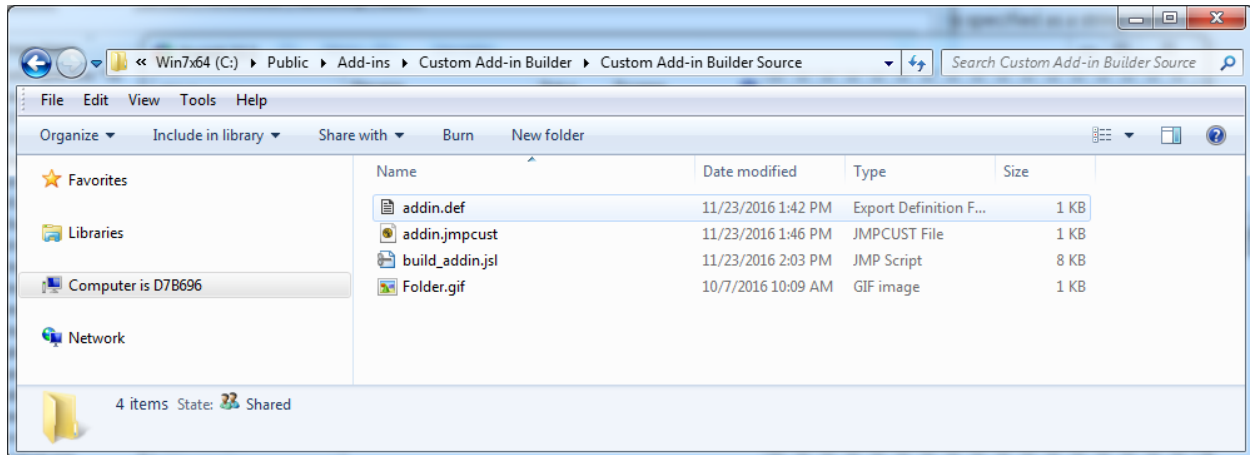
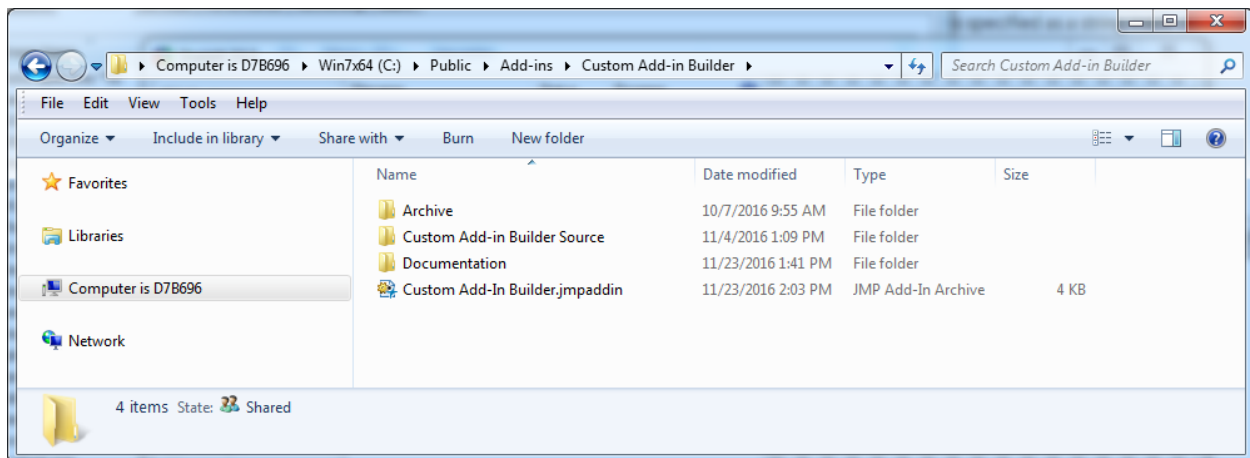


## Custom Add-in Builder: Step-by-step setup guide

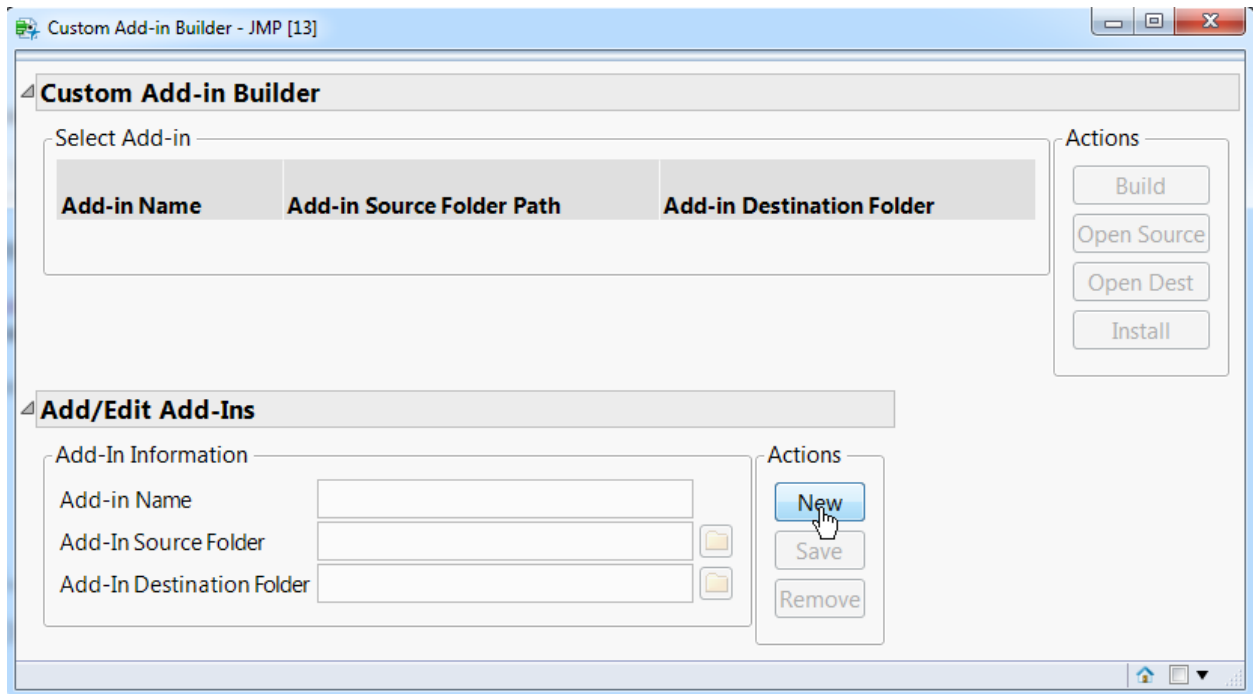
1. Establish a source folder containing any files used by your add-in. It should also contain the `addin.def` and `addin.jmpcust` files.



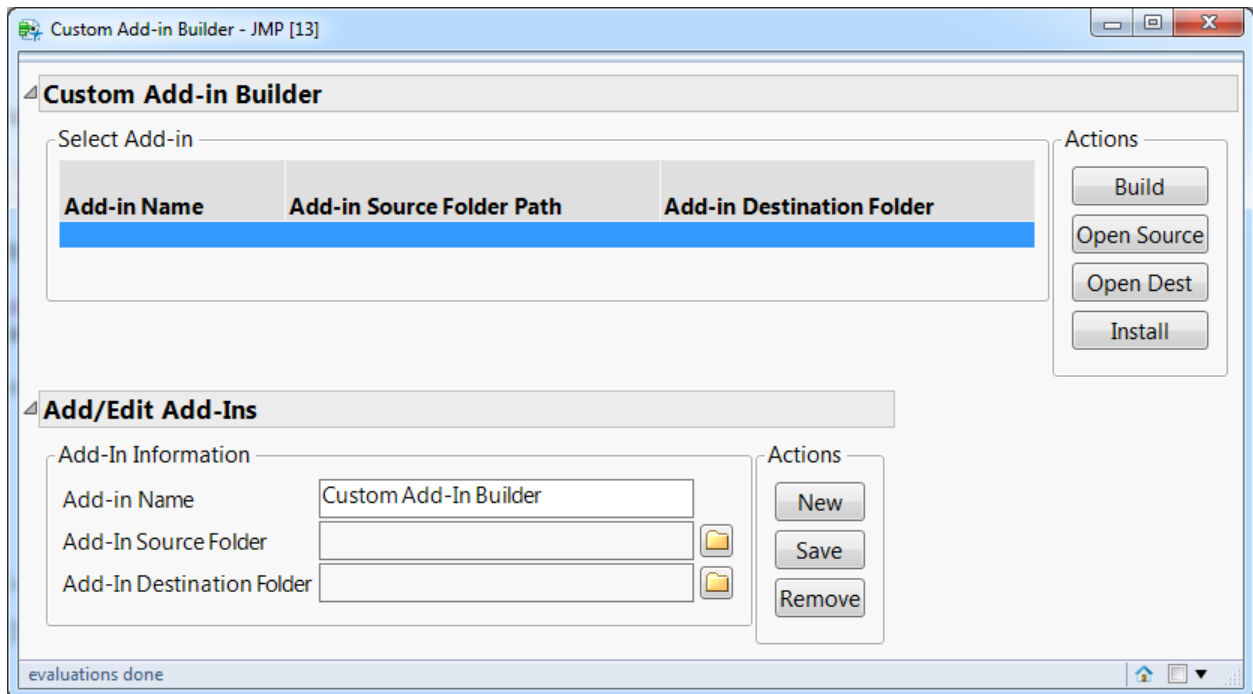
2. Establish a destination location. This will be where your `.jmpaddin` file is saved.



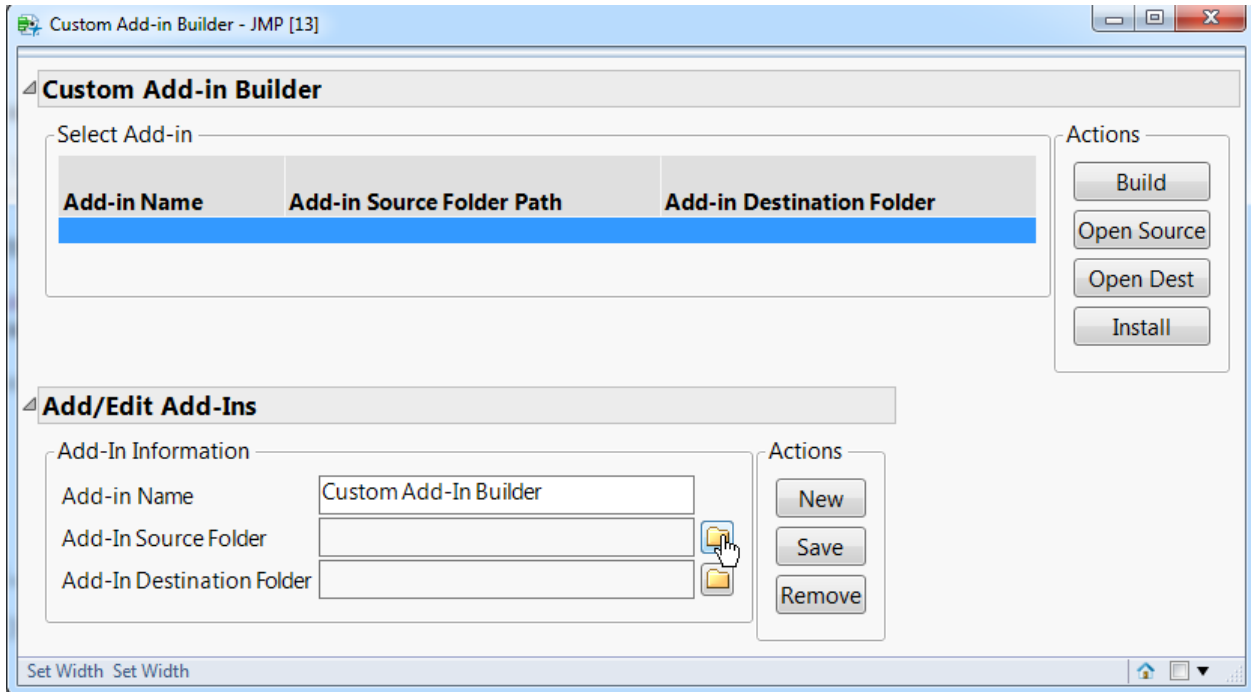
3. Click New to create a new entry for the add-in.



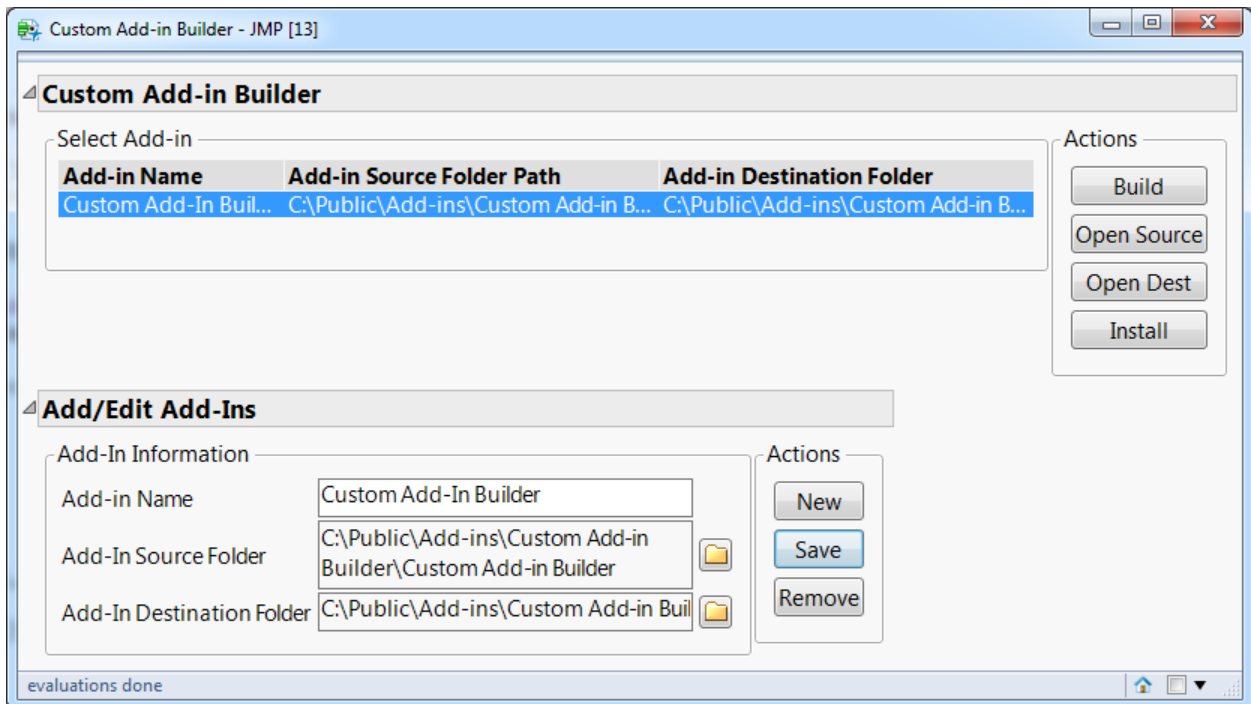
4. Give add-in a name (to be the name of the jmpaddin file).



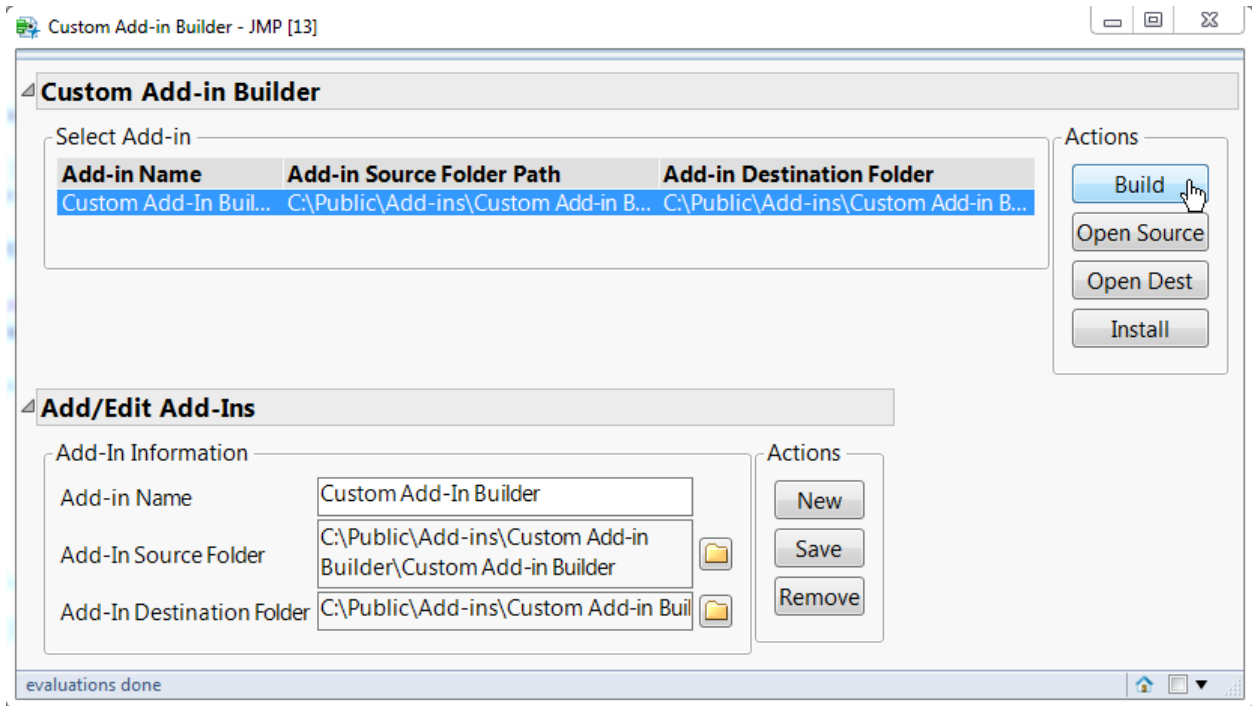
5. Click Folder icon to select a source folder. Repeat for destination folder.



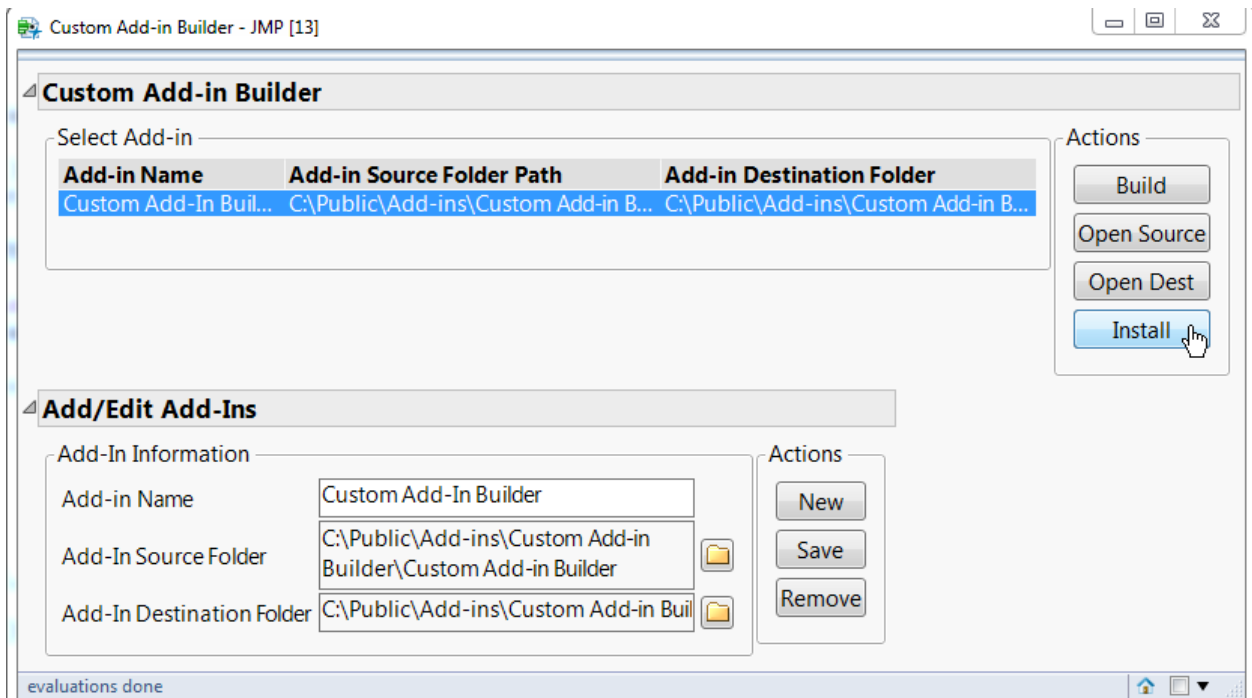
6. Click "Save" to save this configuration so that it the add-in can be created



- With the add-in selected, click the “Build” button to create the .jmpaddin file. This file will be placed in the Add-in Destination folder



- Click “Install” to install the selected add-in



9. Confirm that you want to install the add-in.
